

Introductory Rites:

Penitential Act:

Priest: Brothers & sisters, let us acknowledge our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries.

All: I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

Priest: May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life.

All: Amen.

Kyrie:

Priest: Lord, have mercy. **All:** Lord, have mercy.

Priest: Christ, have mercy.All: Christ, have mercy.Priest: Lord, have mercy.All: Lord, have mercy.

ORDER OF MASS REMINDER SHEET

Gloria:

All: Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Priest: Let us pray. (Pause)
All: (After the priest says the collective prayer)
Amen. (Sit)

Liturgy of the Word:

Lector: (At the end of the first reading) The Word of the Lord. **All:** Thanks be to God.

Responsorial Psalm (Sometimes sung)

Lector: (At the end of the second reading) The Word of the Lord. **All:** Thanks be to God.

(Stand) Alleluia (Sometimes sung)

Gospel reading from Priest/Deacon: The Lord be with you. All: And with your spirit. Priest: A reading from the holy Gospel according to (Matthew, Mark, Luke or John). **All:** (Everyone makes a sign of the cross on their forehead, lips and over their hearts.) Glory to you, O Lord.

At the end of the Gospel reading: The Gospel of the Lord.

All: Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ. (Sit)

Priest's Homily

Prayers of the Faithful:

Lector: After each prayer, speaker says: let us pray to the Lord.

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

(Sit)

Liturgy of the Eucharist:

Priest: Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the bread we offer you: fruit of the earth and work of human hands, it will become for us the bread of life.

All: Blessed be God forever.

Priest: Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the wine we offer you: fruit of the vine and work of human hands it will become our spiritual drink.

All: Blessed be God forever.

Priest: (Stand) Pray, my brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father. All: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church. (After the priest says the prayer over the Offerings)

All: Amen
